Santander AM poaches fund selector from Coutts

Santander Asset Management has hired fund selector Oriana Mezini for its fund research team, the firm has announced.

Mezini will cover emerging market equities and report to head of manager research and selection, José María Martínez-Sanjuán.

She previously worked at Coutts Bank, where she had been since 2016, covering emerging markets, Asia-Pacific and Japan in the fund research division. Prior to that, she worked as a senior fund analyst at Allfunds Bank. Over the past two years, Santander AM has made four appointments to the fund selection team.
